



your Major Degree, please contact me 516-404-5201 or 516-333-2340 M-F 9-5pm.



Next month at the May meeting we will be voting on our new slate of officers for the next Columbian year. For those of you who have your Major Degree please let me know if you want to run for an office.



- The bible (241)
- Dante Alighieri's, Divine Comedy (135)
- Cervantes (Don Quiote) (370)

Dore reached a point where he would sketch the illustrations and his staff of 40 would carve them.
