That being said this bug could make a comeback like in France one day at the bottom of the curve and the next week higher than ever I think they put their guard down.


We are having a Council installations in the upcoming month and I wish all well, I will be installing the new Officers and we will be following all safety guidelines to insure everyone's safety.




