thanks to our Council members for a job well done.








#### PRAYER FOR THE CANONIZATION OF THE VENERABLE SERVANT OF GOD MICHAEL McGIVNEY



# Keep Christ in Christmas Poster Contest

If pastels, chalk or charcoal are used, the poster must be laminated or covered with clear plastic.

Child's name, age and phone number must be written on the back of the poster and submitted with an entry form and may be dropped off at St. Kilian's Rectory during normal business hours.



#### **Suffolk Chapter Report**


My Brothers and Sisters,
